**The Governor of the Central Bank of Tunisia participates
to the works of the IMF World Bank annual meetings in
Washington**

September 23-25, 2011

The Governor of the Central Bank of Tunisia participated to the works of IMF World Bank annual meetings held September 23-25, 2011 in Washington.

These meetings works focused on the action plan to be set up to face risks tied to developed countries sovereign debt problems, the vulnerability of the financial system, the slowdown of economic growth and the high level of unemployment.

Apart from these meetings, the Governor of the Central Bank had talks with the heads of IMF World Bank main technical departments. These talks were on the political and economic situation in Tunisia as well as on the programs of technical assistance and training that the Central Bank intends to implement in view of the reforms to be undertaken in banking supervision and foreign exchange reserves management.

On the other hand, the Governor of the Central Bank met chairmen of international banks and Governors of Central Banks. These meetings dealt with actions to be taken for a better cooperation and expertise trade off in the fields linked with the professions of the bank.

The trend of the political and economic situation in transition countries notably Tunisia was the topic of seminars and panels that the Governor attended with the participation of high level European and Arab lecturers. These meetings intended to investors, bankers and financial markets analysts were organized by well known specialized institutions and research centres.
